Our implementing partner, **Innovation**: Africa (IA), an Israeli NGO (Non-Governmental Organization), drills up to 250 meters (820 ft) to reach the aquifer, and is capable of pumping over 20,000 liters of clean, life-giving water per day, per village.





IA'S LIVE TECHNOLOGY

Managed by iA, our projects are 100% **successful** and tracked in real time by the Remote Monitoring System, which received the Innovation Award from the United Nations.







The world-renowned technology makes our projects resistant to breakdown, vandalism, theft, and typical problems faced by water systems installed by other aid organizations.

Once water is provided, Israeli NGO CultivAid transfers knowledge and implements innovative and sustainable farming solutions. Research with Hebrew University enables CultivAid to support agricultural development to ensure food security, decrease childhood stunting and improve overall nutrition, while providing opportunities for economic advancement.





Optimal agricultural technology, such as drip irrigation, enables farmers to grow larger quantities of nutritious foods with minimal water, resulting in 5-12 times the yield!




